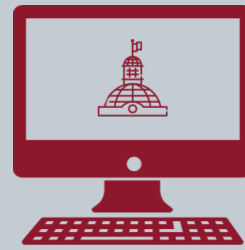


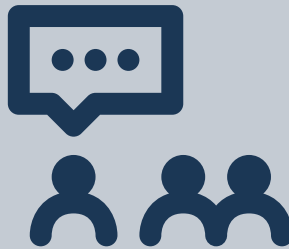
Advocacy from Home Virtual Capitol Day



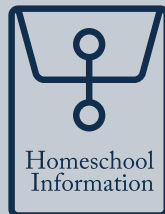
In a normal year, FPM and CHEA host Capitol Day. Homeschool families visit every state legislators' Capitol office in Sacramento to discuss private home education and build a rapport that will leave a lasting, positive impression of homeschooling.

Due to COVID-19, this in-person event is not possible. In its place, FPM and CHEA of California are hosting a virtual event.

This event will feature special speakers with insights on the inner workings of the Capitol and the importance of your involvement in advocacy. In the past, our speakers have included legislators and their staff members, who speak to us about their experience and prepare us for our visits to all the legislators' offices.



All Virtual Capitol Day and Advocacy from Home participants must undergo an application process for approval prior to meeting with their legislator. Once approved, a homeschool informational packet will be sent to you so you can provide it your legislator.
