

The Big Picture for Recruiters

1. Call and recruit **eligible** families for Virtual Capitol Day and Advocacy from Home
2. Explain to families what the event is, the virtual training involved, special speakers, and **their part** in local advocacy
3. Eligible Families sign up for the event
4. Families are trained by FPM
5. Families meet their legislators
6. Families report back to FPM about their visit at this link: www.fpmca.org/dvisits

Recruiter “Job Description”

- Contact private homeschool families
- Communicate the goal and mission of *Virtual Capitol Day and Advocacy from Home*
- Determine family’s eligibility to participate (see Eligibility slides)
- Explain the questionnaire for district offices (find out what a district offices allows for meetings)
- Send eligible families more info in an email with the application link
- Explain the 2-step application/registration process
