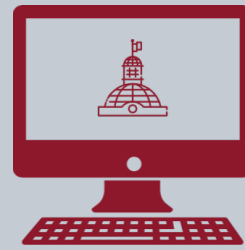


Virtual Capitol Day Advocacy from Home

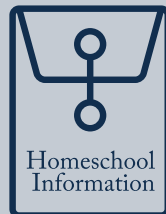
Due to COVID-19, this in-person event is not possible. In its place, FPM and CHEA of California are hosting a virtual event.

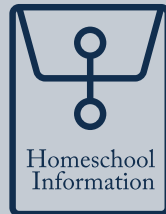


Advocacy from Home
